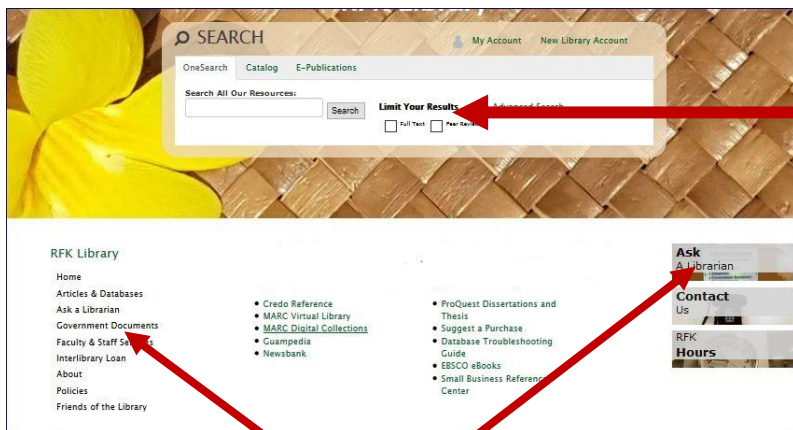


The RFK Interlibrary Loan: Finding Additional resources
