Search Strategy

- Practice a consistent, structured approach to searching key terms in a database.
- Use key concepts within your search question to increase accuracy and relevancy toward your topic.
- Account for all possible search terms, reflecting on your keywords and synonyms and how these influence your search results.

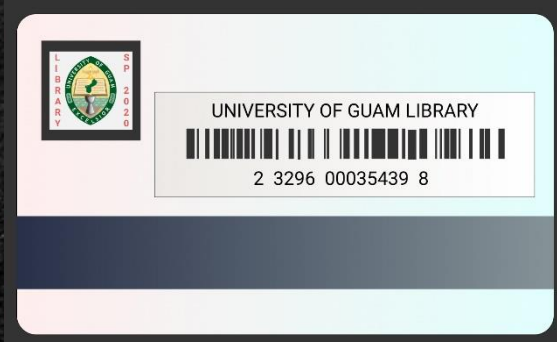

Identify Key Terms

- What are these terms? A subject? Author Name? Artist? Book Title?
 - “My advisor recommended **Keys to Nursing Success** by **Katz**.” (Title and Author)
 - “Where can I find a book on **teaching English** as a **Second Language**?” (Subject)
 - “Do you have a book on **Business Management**” (Subject)
 - “Does the library have current articles on **Takashi Murakami**?” (Name)

Identify Key Terms

- Terms identified can be plugged into the database as a keyword search.
- Keywords can also be compound phrases or full titles.
- Adding an optional field to search helps find what you are looking for.

Example:

“My advisor recommended **Keys to Nursing Success** by **Katz**.”

(Title of Book + Author)

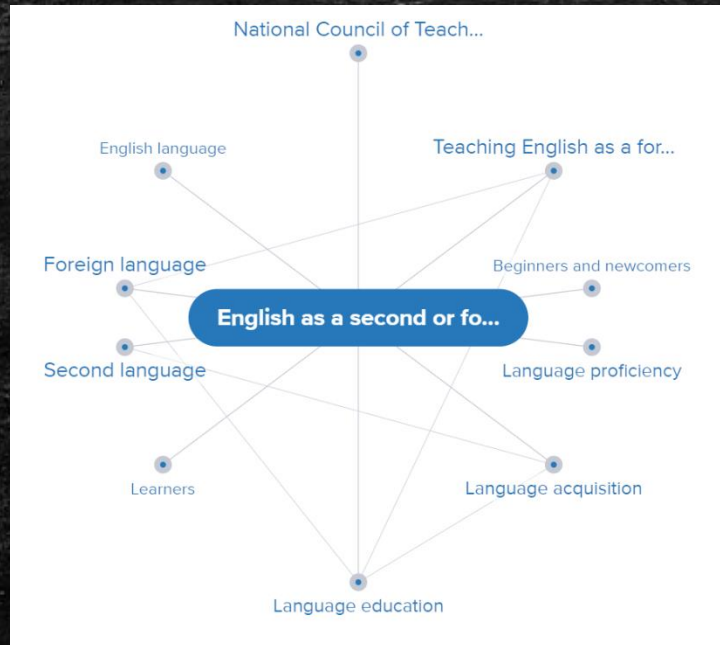

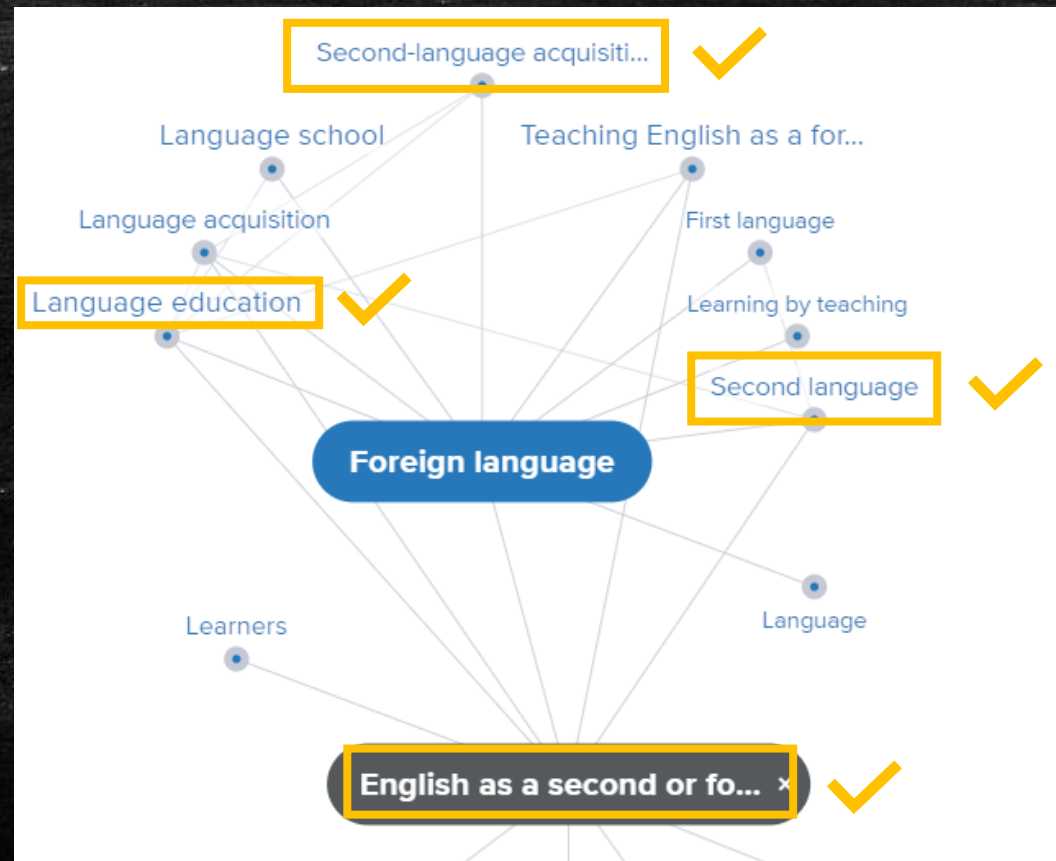

Broad vs Narrow

- Broad terms increase the amount of results in a database.
- Specific terms increase the relevancy of results in a database.

Tip: Start broad and gradually increase the specificity of your search to determine what works best.

Broad vs Narrow (examples)

Broad terms will yield more results including more variation.

Equivalency & Synonymous Terms

- Equivalency Terms and Synonyms can be used in place of your original keyword.
- Relevant articles can be retrieved with a synonym, alternate spelling, phrase, common abbreviation, or closely related term.

- Football or Soccer
- Color or Colour
- Art or Fine Art or Visual Art
- Theater or Theatre or Performance Art
- Education or Teaching
- Administration or Management
- English as Second Language or ESL
- Environment or Climate

Equivalency & Synonymous Terms

- Using **Onesearch**, typing in "OR" after entering your keyword can be used to reveal additional phrases before clicking Search.



Boolean Operators to Increase Accurate Database Results

Use Boolean terms with more than one keyword to alter your search results.

AND:

Results always include both subject A and Subject B.
If it lacks either A or B, it is excluded from the results.
Example: A+B only.



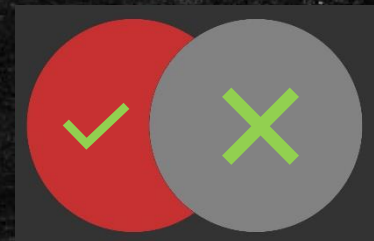
OR:

Results include anything that has either A or B in its content,
even if one of them are missing.
Example: A, B, and A+B.

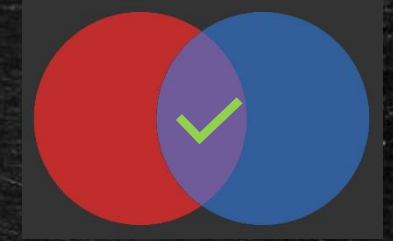


NOT:

Used to exclude.
Example: A NOT B.

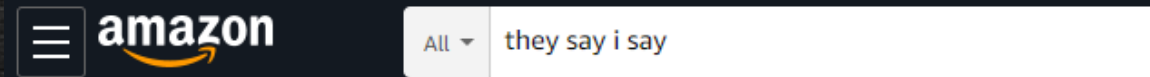
Alternative Strategies

- If you have exhausted many strategies without results, do not simply give up your search.
- Take advantage of algorithms on Google and Amazon to find editions, missing metadata information, and cross check sources.

IMPORTANT TIP: If you find at least ONE great book or article, use its reference section to gather many primary sources. You may repeat this process with each reference cited, gradually forming a web of relevant information.

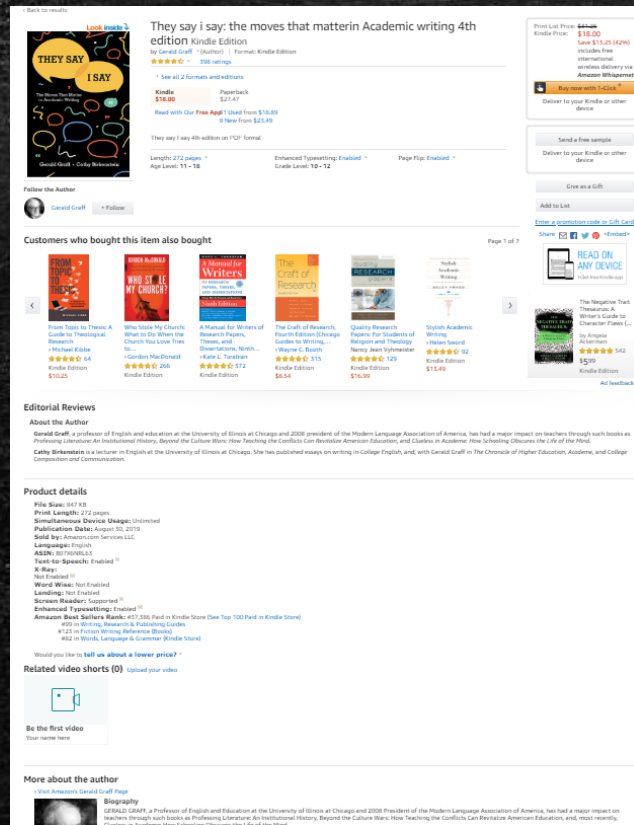

Guam (/ɡwɑːm/ (listen); Chamorro: *Guåhån* [ɡʷɑhɔn]) is an organized, unincorporated territory of the United States in Micronesia in the western Pacific Ocean.^{[a][4]} It is the westernmost point and territory of the United States, along with the Northern Mariana Islands. The capital city of Guam is Hagåtña and the most populous city is Dededo. Guam has been a member of the Pacific Community since 1983. The inhabitants of Guam are called Guamanians, and they are American citizens by birth. The indigenous Guamanians are the Chamorros, who are related to other Austronesian natives of Eastern Indonesia, the Philippines, and Taiwan.

In 2016, 162,742 people resided on Guam. Guam has an area of 210 square miles (540 km²; 130,000 acres) and a population density of 775 per square mile (299/km²). In Oceania, it is the largest and southernmost of the Mariana Islands and the largest island in Micronesia. Among its municipalities, Mongmong-Toto-Maite has the highest population density at 3,691 per square mile (1,425/km²), whereas Inarajan and Umatac have the lowest density at 119 per square mile (46/km²). The highest point is Mount Lamlam at 1,332 feet (406 m) above sea level. Since the 1960s, the economy has been supported by two industries: tourism and the United States Armed Forces.^[5]

The indigenous Chamorros settled the island approximately 4,000 years ago. Portuguese explorer Ferdinand Magellan, while in the service of Spain, was the first European to visit the island, on March 6, 1521. Guam was colonized by Spain in 1668 with settlers, including Diego Luis de San Vitores, a Catholic Jesuit missionary. Between the 16th century and the 18th century, Guam was an important stopover for the Spanish Manila Galleons. During the Spanish–American


